(The covenant between God and Noah)

God then said to Noah and his family, "I hereby establish my covenant with you and with your descendants after you, and with every living creature that is with you - birds, cattle, and the earth's wildlife - everything that came out of the ark, everything that lives on the earth. I hereby establish my covenant with you: All flesh will never again be swept away by the waters of the flood; never again will a flood destroy all the earth."

God said, "Here is the sign of the covenant between me and you and every living creature for ageless generations: I set my bow in the clouds, and it will be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth. When I bring clouds over the earth, my bow will appear in the clouds.

Abram fell on his face before God, and God said to him, "This is my covenant with you: you will be the ancestor of many nations. You are no longer to be called Abram, "Respected Parent, " but Abraham, "Progenitor of a Multitude," for you are the progenitor of a multitude of nations. I will make you most fruitful, and I will make nations of you, and rulers will spring from you.
