

Protocols for indoor renters at Melville

Effective November 1, 2021 unless we or governments change the status.

*All people must be double vaccinated unless under 12 years of age.

Groups wishing to rent space must present their own COVID-19 protocol plan.

Only the number of people allowed by government regulations, including the leader is allowed at one time. If it's a children's group, parents need to wait outside. (For preschoolers, parents who are double vaccinated may enter and watch).

People need to sanitize hands upon entering. Group leaders will keep track of names and phone numbers for participants. This list will be left in the mail slot of the church office when activities are finished.

Masks must be worn, and social distancing must be in place unless this changes because of vaccinations and government restrictions. Please refer to government protocol regarding masks and strenuous activities.

Each renter is restricted to only the room they are renting (This should always be the case).

There could be a group in both or either of the two large rooms of the church. If using the downstairs room those people would use the back door near the garden. Groups using the upstairs room would use the main parking lot door.

If your rental time has more than one class/group, please allow time for cleaning/sanitizing in between.

If a case is discovered connected to Melville, all groups will be cancelled.

Each group will be expected to clean/sanitize after use.

Priority will be given to former renters.

Each renter will wipe down any touched surface that their participants come into contact with using a government approved sanitizer provided.
